TUESDAY, AUGUST 24 - CAIRO

(D)

Upon arrival in Cairo, you will be met by a Ya'lla Tours USA representative and transferred to your hotel for overnight. HILTON PYRAMIDS GOLF RESORT is located near the Pyramids of Giza, (no view from hotel). All guest rooms have balconies and floor-to-ceiling opening windows, air-conditioning, satellite TV, wi-fi internet, safe and hair dryer. WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 25 - CAIRO

(B,L,D)

Drive to Sakara to see the prototype of the Pyramids, the Step Pyramid, built for the 3rd Dynasty Pharaoh Djoser by the exalted architect Imhotep. Lunch en route. Drive to Giza and visit a Pyramid, a Royal Burial Chamber, the Valley Temple, and the Sphinx. Then visit the Solar Boat, one of the most amazing Pharaonic discoveries. End the day with a visit to the Papyrus Institute. Dinner tonight will be served at a 5-star hotel



THURSDAY, AUGUST 26 - ASWAN

(B,D)

You will be transferred to Cairo airport for your Egypt Air flight #381 to Aswan, departing at 8:30AM and arriving at 9:55AM. Upon arrival, you will be met by a Ya'lla Tours USA local representative and start your tour. Visit Aswan High Dam, Egypt's contemporary example of building on a

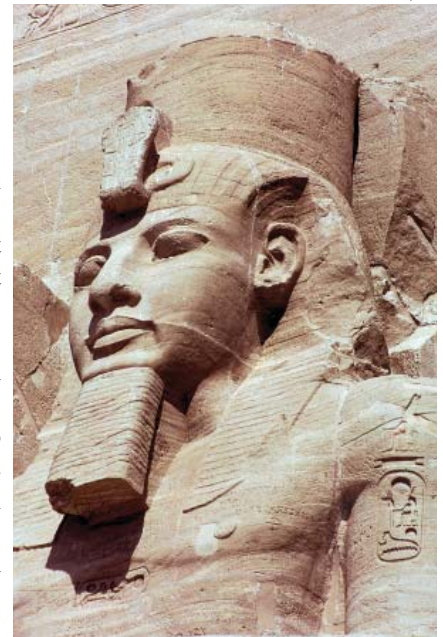
monumental scale. Next, proceed to the granite quarries which supplied the ancient Egyptians with most of the hard stone used in pyramids and temples. The quarries still hold the Unfinished Obelisk, possibly intended as a companion to the Lateran Obelisk, originally at Karnak but now in Rome. It would have weighed over 1,100 tons and would have been the world's largest piece of stone ever handled. Continue by a short motor-boat ride to the Temple of Philae on the island of Agilka. The temple was dedicated to Isis, sister/wife of Osiris and patroness of the Ptolemaic rule. Then drive to the hotel for check in. In the afternoon take a felucca ride around Elephantine Island, the largest of the Aswan area islands and site of some of the most ancient ruins in Egypt, some dating to the pre-dynastic period. Continue sailing around Kitchener Island. From the river you have a nice view of the Aga Khan Mausoleum, an elegant pink granite structure built in the late 1950's. We'll end the day with a real treat. Board Ya'lla's own dahabiya (Ankh I) for cocktails and dinner. ISIS ISLAND is a 4.5-star property located on a private island in the Nile with views of the city of Aswan and the sandy mountains. The resort offers sport and recreation facilities, as well as a full-service spa. All 447 rooms have air-conditioning, private bathrooms, telephone, refrigerator, safe, satellite TV, hair dryer and a balcony. Hotel facilities include 4 restaurants, 2 bars, 2 outdoor swimming pools, beauty parlor, laundry, 24-hour room service, 4 tennis courts and a pool table. www.pyramisaegypt.com/pyramisaisisisland



FRIDAY, AUGUST 27 - NILE CRUISE (Aswan) (B,D)

Drive along Lake Nasser to Abu Simbel. Visit the twin temples of Ramesses II and Nefertari. The entire complex of temples was moved to its present location 90 feet

above its old site to protect it from the rising water of the Nile when the Aswan Dam was built in the early sixties. Drive back to Aswan and board your Nile Cruise for dinner and overnight. AMARCO I is one of the most deluxe boats on the Nile today. This 233-foot-long, 43-foot-wide all-suite vessel provides the ultimate luxury in Nile cruising. Suites are spacious and elegantly appointed and equipped with air-conditioning, safe box, mini-fridge, 5-channel satellite TV with closed video circuit, music system, internal telephone, and bathrooms with bathtub and hair dryer. Luxurious and comfortable public areas invite quests to relax and mingle in the open-air. Onboard facilities include 2 elevators, spacious restaurants serving the best Egyptian and international cuisine, lounges with dancing every evening, large swimming pools, gym, spa, massage, steam rooms, Jacuzzis, sun decks, a variety of bars and lounges, boutiques and gift shops. optimacruises.com

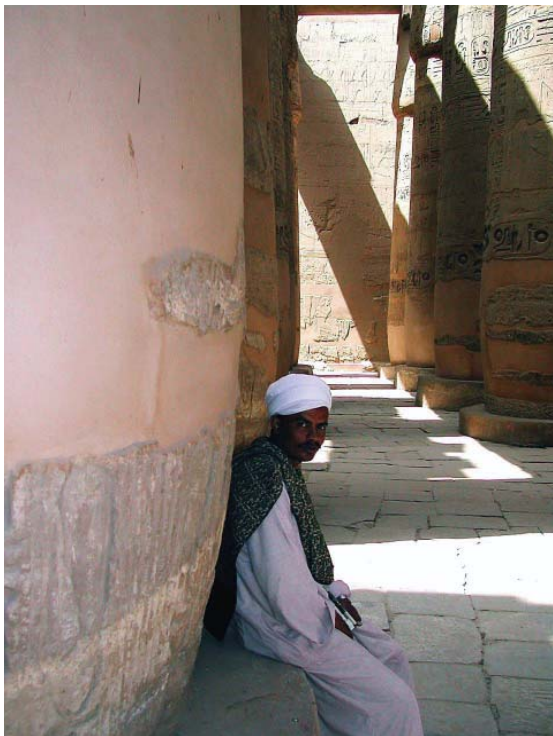


SATURDAY, AUGUST 28 - NILE CRUISE (Edfu) (B,L,D)

Sail to Kom Ombo and visit the Temple of Sobek, the crocodile-headed god of fertility and creator of the world. The temple stands at a bend in the Nile where, in ancient times, sacred crocodiles basked in the sun on the riverbank. Return to your cruise and sail to Edfu. Set out by horse-drawn carriage to visit the Temple of Horus, the largest and most perfectly preserved of all the Nile temples. Horus, also known as Haroeris, was the falcon-headed solar war god.

SUNDAY, AUGUST 29 - NILE CRUISE (Luxor) (B,L,D)

Sail through Esna and continue to Luxor. Cross to the west bank of the Nile and visit the wondrous Valley of the Kings, a vast city of the dead, where the magnificent tombs of over 60 pharaohs have been discovered. The tombs were carved deep into the desert rock, richly decorated and filled with treasures for the afterlife of the pharaohs. Visit several of the tombs. Next, visit the Temple of Hatshepsut. This beautiful monument to the reign of the only female pharaoh rises out of the desert plain in a series of terraces and merges with the sheer limestone cliffs that surround it. On the way back to your Nile cruise, stop at the famed Colossi of Memnon, two 66ft, 1 thousand ton statues of Amenhotep III. These colossal statues were known by the ancient Greeks to emit haunting voices at dawn. Though damaged by nature and ancient tourists, the statues are still impressive.



MONDAY, AUGUST 30 - CAIRO (B,D)

After breakfast onboard disembark your cruise. Visit the Karnak Temple, known as the “Temple of Temples.” It is the largest place of worship ever built. Its ancient name Ipet-isut means “the most sacred of places.” The temple was built over more than two thousand years by generation after generation of pharaohs. Within the complex, the great “Hypostyle Hall” is an incredible forest of giant pillars covering an area larger than the whole of Notre Dame Cathedral. Proceed to the graceful Temple of Luxor built by Amenhotep III and Ramesses II and dedicated to the god Amun. You will be transferred to Luxor airport for your Egypt Air flight #354 to Cairo, departing at 2:15PM and arriving at 3:25PM. Upon arrival in Cairo you will be met by a Ya’lla Tours representative and transferred to your hotel for check in. GRAND HYATT is a 5-star property located on an island in the Nile, in the center of Cairo. All 700 rooms have breathtaking views and a private balcony overlooking the river, mini-bar, robes, hair dryer, high speed internet, and safe. TUESDAY, AUGUST 31 - CAIRO (B,L)

Visit the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities. Among other fascinating exhibits, see the treasures of the Tomb of Tutankhamen and the extraordinary Mummies Room. Lunch en route. Continue to Old Cairo and visit the Old Coptic Church and the Ben Ezra Synagogue. Continue to the Mohamad Ali Mosque and the streets of Khan el Khalili Bazaar. Dinner tonight will be on your own so you can experience how it is to navigate this vast city on your own.

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 01 - CAIRO (B,L,D)

At 8:30AM we will begin our full day seminar: “Tourism in Egypt in the New Millennium” Increase your business by taking advantage of this extraordinary opportunity. Ronen Paldi, President of Ya’lla Tours USA and Mr. Nagui Kadri of Ya’lla Tours Egypt will conduct the seminar. Lunch will be served.
