SUNDAY, MAY 06 -

Depart Dallas with Delta Airlines flight #1710 nonstop to Atlanta, leaving at 12:00pm and arriving at 3:09pm. Connect with Delta Airlines flight #122 nonstop to New York's JFK airport, leaving at 5:25pm and arriving at 7:55pm. Connect with Delta Airlines flight #268 nonstop to Tel Aviv, leaving at 9:25pm.

MONDAY, MAY 07 - JERUSALEM

Upon arrival at Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport at 3:15pm you will be met by a Ya'lla Tours USA representative and transferred to your hotel for dinner and overnight. Our hotel, DAVID CITADEL, is a beautiful, 5-star deluxe hotel located in downtown Jerusalem, across from the Jaffa Gate. www.tdchotel.com (D)

TUESDAY, MAY 08 - JERUSALEM

Drive to the eastern side of Mt. of Olives to the Church of Bethpage. Visit the ancient first-century tomb and the church from which Jesus went up to Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. Continue to Mt. of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Visit the Church of the Ascension. Walk down the Mount of Olives to the site of Jesus' Agony. Visit the Church of Pater Noster, located on the hill where Jesus was inspired with the Our Father prayer. The walls of the church are covered with the prayer written in over 85 languages. Walk down to the Garden of Gethsemane at the foot of the Mount of Olives. Today it appears much as it did 20 centuries ago and contains some of the world's oldest olive trees. The garden was a spot favored by Jesus for meditation and prayer. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B,D)

WEDNESDAY, MAY 09 - JERUSALEM

Visit the House of Chiapas, chief priest of the Jews, where Jesus was held prior to his trial. Visit the City of David and see the excavations that reveal the earliest days of Jerusalem, dating back to King David. Optional: walk through Hezekiah's Tunnel. Drive to Mt. Zion and visit King David's Tomb and the Last Supper Room. Enter the Jewish quarter of the Old City through the Zion Gate for a walking tour. Walk down to the Western Wall, the holiest site in Judaism and the only visible remains of Herod's splendid Second Temple where Jesus walked and taught. See the Temple Steps, the original set of 15 steps leading to the Temple's Entrance to the Court of the Israelites. At the Davidson Center, watch the multi-media presentation about Jerusalem in the days of Jesus. Walk through the Western Wall Tunnel, huge arched spaces just north of the Western Wall which link to a water tunnel cut through the rock to the north, apparently dug in the Hasmonean period (163 to 37 BC). Then return to hotel for dinner and overnight. (B,D)

THURSDAY, MAY 10 - JERUSALEM

Drive to the ruins of Caesarea, a large port city built by Herod the Great to honor Roman Caesar Augustus. Herod built a port in the bay and erected all the cultural institutions found in every great Greco-Roman city - a theater, a hippodrome, and a luxurious bathhouse. In order to supply water to the city's ever-growing population, he built an aqueduct system stretching from the springs of Mt. Carmel to Caesarea. Part of this system is still visible today. The Book of Acts refers repeatedly to Caesarea as the city Peter visited. (Acts 10) At the Sea of Galilee, take a private boat ride to see the 2,000 year old Genosar Boat discovered in 1986.

May 6-18, 2012





This is a Galilee fishing boat from approximately the 1st century A.D., preserved in the muddy sediment of the lake floor and revealed when the lake receded to record low levels. Enjoy a St. Peter's fish lunch by the Sea of Galilee. Visit Capernaum, where Jesus preached, and his disciples, Peter, Andrew, and perhaps others, made their homes. The contemporary church at Tabga celebrates the Miracle of the Multiplication. Note the mosaic floor from a Byzantine-era church, and the section in front of the ancient altar depicting two fish and a basket filled with loaves of bread. Drive to the Mount of the Beatitudes, site of the Sermon on the Mount. (Matt: 05) Return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)

FRIDAY, MAY 11 - JERUSALEM

Drive to the Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial. May we never forget the terrible price Israel paid to establish her country. A local cantor will join us for a memorial service. Then on to the Israel Museum and the Dead Sea Scrolls exhibition at the Shrine of the Book. Then see the model of the city as it was in the days of Jesus. Then drive to Jericho, the oldest city in the world. Take the cable car to Mt. of Temptations and visit the synagogue. We'll end the day at the Jordan River Kasr el Yhaud site for Baptism. Return to the hotel for a private Shabbat dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B,D)

SATURDAY, MAY 12 - EILAT

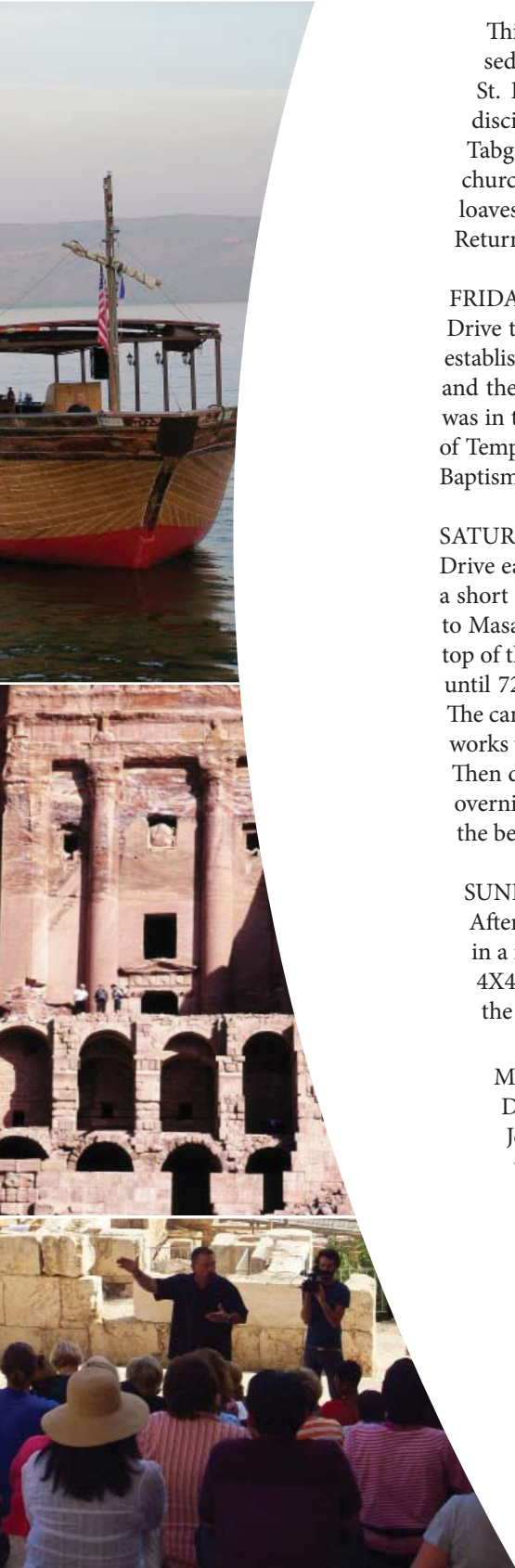
Drive east to the lowest place on earth: the Dead Sea. Stop at the Ein Gedi Nature Reserve and take a short hike to David's Falls and see the area where the young David hid from King Saul. Continue to Masada, a natural fortress with majestic ruins overlooking the Dead Sea. Take a cable car to the top of the plateau for a tour. Jewish zealots held the rock against the unrelenting 10th Roman legion until 72 AD, when a monumental siege, using an astounding attack ramp, conquered the fortress. The camps and other fortifications that encircle the mesa constitute the most complete Roman siege works to have survived to the present day. Descend by cable car and drive to the Dead Sea for lunch. Then drive along the Arava Valley to Eilat, Israel's most vibrant city on the Red Sea, for dinner and overnight. Our hotel, DAN EILAT, is one of Israel's most beautiful 5-star deluxe hotels, located on the beach of the Red Sea, within 5 minutes from downtown Eilat. www.danhotels.com (B,L,D)

SUNDAY, MAY 13 - EILAT

After a relaxing morning, visit the Underwater Observatory and observe life under the Red Sea in a most unusual way. Continue to the Timna Park and visit King Solomon's Pillars. Next, take a 4X4 jeep ride into the Edom Mountains and desert, where we will have a BBQ lunch. Return to the hotel for a free afternoon, dinner and overnight. (B,L,D)

MONDAY, MAY 14 - EILAT

Drive to the Arava border crossing with Jordan. Cross to Jordan and meet your Ya'lla Tours Jordanian guide and drive to Petra. Travel on horseback to the siq (canyon), and then on foot to Petra. Known as Sela Edom or Red Rock City, Petra was the capital of the Nabateans from the 3rd-century B.C. to the 2nd-century A.D. Petra's most elegant monument, el Khazneh (the Treasury) comes dramatically into view as you emerge from the siq. Beyond The Treasury an entire city is carved into the canyon walls. Other outstanding structures include the Monastery and Urn Tomb. Wander through the field of tombs and obelisks to al Madhbah (the Altar). From this point you can view the whole of the rock city. (As a great deal of walking is included in the visit, we suggest good walking shoes and a lightweight jacket). The most adventurous will be invited to hike up to the spiritual High Place, site of the sacrificial alter and offering a spectacular view of the ancient city and surroundings. Have lunch in Petra. Return to Eilat for dinner and overnight. Tonight, we will say goodbye to Pastors Larry and Tiz and wish them all the best and safe travels. (B,L,D)





TUESDAY, MAY 15 - TEL AVIV

Today is at your leisure in Eilat to enjoy the beach, the sun and the facilities of Israel's best resort. By 2:00pm, depart Eilat through the Negev and the Ramon Crater to arrive Tel Aviv at 6:00pm. Our hotel, DAN TEL AVIV, is one of Tel Aviv's most elegant 5-star deluxe hotels, located at the heart of Tel Aviv's Proenade, within walking distance to the famous Dizengoff Street. www.danhotels.com (B)

Depart Tel Aviv at 12:05am, arrive New York's JFK airport at 4:45am. Clear U.S. Customs and Immigration and connect with Delta Airlines flight #27 nonstop to Atlanta, leaving at 8:15am and arriving at 10:52am. Connect with Delta Airlines flight #2010 nonstop to Dallas Ft. Worth, departing at 12:30pm and arriving at 1:54pm.

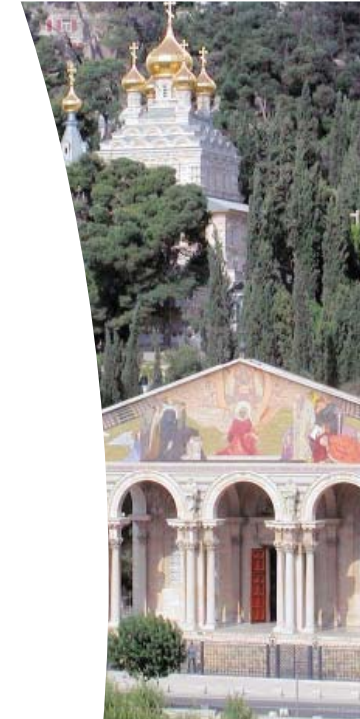

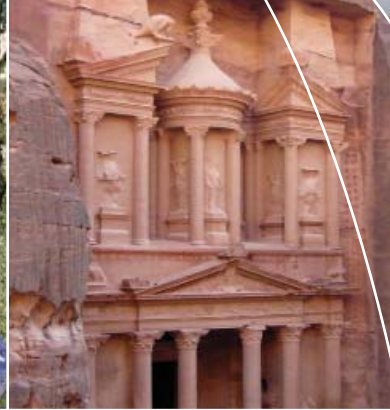

TERMS & CONDITIONS

PRICE:

- The price of the tour is: \$5,795/person in a double room or \$7,290 in a single room based on a minimum of 45 passengers. The price is guaranteed but if due to unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of Ya'lla Tours USA, our suppliers increase the price, we will adjust the price accordingly.
- Price of the airfare portion of the tour is subject to change until the air ticket is issued.
- The single room supplement will apply to single travelers unless a roommate can be found.
- Should the number of participants, 90 days prior to departure, be lower than the published minimum number of participants to operate the tour, the price will be adjusted accordingly, or the tour will be canceled.

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT:

A deposit of \$800 is due upon registration. **Final payment is due February 6, 2012.**

CANCELLATIONS & REFUND:

- For cancellation before February 6, 2012, a \$250 per person administrative fee will apply.
- Cancellation after February 6, 2012 but before making final payment will forfeit the deposit in full.
- For cancellation 89-45 days prior to departure, a fee of 50% of the cost of the tour will apply.
- For cancellation 44-15 days prior to departure, a fee of 75% of the cost of the tour will apply.
- For cancellation 14 or fewer days prior to departure, a fee of 100% of the cost of the tour will apply.
- No refund will be paid for unused services such as: transfers, sight-seeing, meals, hotel, entrance fees, etc.

PASSENGER RESPONSIBILITY:

Passenger has read the above terms and conditions and agrees to each of them. Passenger hereby warrants that he/she fully understand each of them. Specifically passenger understands that should he/she cancel their trip for any reason, passenger will be charged the cancellation fee set out above.

PASSPORT AND DOCUMENTATION:

Passports must be valid for at least six months following the return date from your destination.

RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY:

Whereas Ya'lla Tours USA Inc. and the participating airlines and tour operators operate the land tours offered under this program only as agents of the aircraft, railroads, car rental contractors, steamship lines, hotels, bus operators, sight-seeing contractors and others who provide the actual land arrangements, we are not liable for any act, omission, delay, injury, loss or damage or nonperformance occurring in connection with these tours.

The Passenger contract in use by the airline concerned, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the airline and the purchaser of these tours and/or passenger.

Ya'lla Tours USA Inc. reserves the right to bring legal action to collect damages in the event that purchaser fails to pay any fees due and owing for services, including cancellation fees as set out in the section entitled 'Cancellations & Refunds'. The parties agree that should legal action be commenced, the prevailing party will be entitled to his/her or its reasonable attorney fees and court costs in addition to the actual damages sustained and proven. Venue for any dispute is Multnomah County Circuit Court, Oregon. This contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Oregon.

The Tour Operator reserves the right to change the itinerary due to unforeseen circumstances. In all cases, Ya'lla Tours USA Inc. will strive to maintain the content of the tour. The Tour operator reserves the right to change the hotels listed on the tour for others of similar quality.

ENTIRE AGREEMENT SEVERABILITY:

This is the entire agreement of the parties and it may be amended only by written agreement signed by Ya'lla Tours USA Inc. and the client. If any part of this agreement is held unenforceable by a court of law, the rest of this agreement will nevertheless remain in force and effect.
