NOVEMBER 26 – DECEMBER 07, 2008***

**WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 26 -**

Depart Seattle with Delta Airlines flight # 1120 **nonstop** to Atlanta leaving at 1:15PM and arriving at 8:59PM. Connect with Delta Airlines flight # 152 **nonstop** to Tel Aviv leaving at 10:35PM.

**THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 27 - KIBBUTZ**

Arrive Tel Aviv at 5:05PM. Upon arrival, you will be met at the airport by **Ya'lla Tours USA** Israel representative and transferred to your hostel for dinner and overnight. Our hotel, **MAAGAN HOLIDAY VILLAGE**, is a 3-star resort located on the waterfront of the Sea of Galilee, only 5 miles south of Tiberias. As a kibbutz hotel it is surrounded by luscious lawns and private gardens. All rooms are air conditioned with TV, telephone and balcony. Facilities include a private beach, swimming pools and a mini zoo.

**FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 28 - KIBBUTZ**

Climb to the Upper Galilee and the city of **Zafed**. Zafed is one of the four holiest Jewish cities and the town carries the mystical ambience of the Kabbalah. Visit the art galleries and the ancient synagogues.

Then, drive north to Kiryat Shemona and see the city that was bombed for so many years by terrorist in Lebanon.

Continue to the ruins of the prehistoric settlement at **Tel Dan**, once a thriving Canaanite community and the northern limit of the Promised Land.

We continue to **Banias** to see the sources of the Jordan River. Then walk to **Caesarea Philippi**, the Biblical name for Banias. It figures in the New Testament as the place where Jesus designated Peter as “the rock” on which the church would be built.

Then stop at **Sha'ar Yishuv** east of Kiryat Shomona on the old border of the Golan Heights, a moshav which took much fire from Syria before the Six Day War. In 1997 this was the site of a national disaster when two IDF helicopters collided mid air above the moshav, killing 73 soldiers.

Continue to the Golan Heights to the Tears, hear the moving story of the brave Kahalani's battle to secure the Golan Heights during the Yom Kippur War.

Continue to **Mt. Bental** for an outstanding view of the Upper Galilee and the Golan Heights.

Drive to **Katzrin**, the only city in the Golan Heights.

Return to your kibbutz for Shabbat dinner and overnight.

### **SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 29 - KIBBUTZ**

Shabbat morning service 9:00AM in the Swiss Forest.

At 11:30AM take a **private** boat ride along the Sea of Galilee to **Kibbutz Genosar**.

After lunch, drive north and stop at **Kfar Nahum** and view the ruins of the Synagogue of the First Century.

Then continue to **Vered Hagalil** dude ranch with an opportunity to ride horse back or ponies for the little ones...paid by each person on the spot.

Enjoy a typical American burger & fries.

We will end the day at the **Jordan River** for your own baptism ceremony.

Return to your kibbutz for dinner and overnight.

### **SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 30 - MITZPE RAMON (Negev Desert)**

Drive to **Mt. Tabor**. Take a taxi to the top of the mountain and visit the Church of the Transfiguration. Enjoy an outstanding view of the Jezrael Valley where the battle of Deborah and the Midianites took place (Judges 5).

Then drive to **Kana** on your way to **Nazareth**, where our Lord spent most of his life, and home to the largest Arab population left in Israel. We will visit the Church of the Annunciation and St. Joseph's Grotto.

Then continue to the heart of the Negev Desert to Mitzpe Ramon for dinner and overnight.

Our hotel, **RAMON INN**, is a real desert hotel. Located in the heart of the Negev on the rim of Israel's Great Crater in the small village of Mitzpe Ramon, this charming hotel of 150 rooms offers a true desert experience.

### **MONDAY, DECEMBER 01 - MITZPE RAMON (Negev Desert)**

We will start our morning with a visit to the Ramon Crater nature reserve and visitor's center. Then we will drive to the archaeological site of **Avdat** to see the ruins of this interesting Nabatean city and learn about the way of life of this once powerful civilization.

Continue to **Sde Boker** and visit Ben Gurion's Hut and Museum.

At 12:00PM, return to the Great Crater for a Hafla, a traditional Bedouin lunch. The experience of this along with the meal will give us a good sense of the desert way of life, very little has changed since the days of the Patriarchs.

Then take a 4X4 jeep ride deep into the Crater, see the life in the desert like you can not imagine exists.

Return to Mitzpe Ramon for dinner and overnight.

## **TUESDAY, DECEMBER 02 - JERUSALEM**

Begin the next phase of our journey north.

At 9:30AM visit to **Hatzerim**, the museum of the Israeli Air Force. This open air museum displays over 90 aircraft, from Israel's first Messerschmidt and the Supermarine Spitfire flown in combat by Ezer Weizman, to the Boeing 707 used in the Entebbe rescue mission.

As sunset approaches, catch a glimpse of Jerusalem as we make our way through the hills to Yad Hashmona for dinner and overnight.

### **MOSHAV: YAD HASHMONA**

## **WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 03 - JERUSALEM**

Drive to Mt. Zion and visit **David's Tomb** and the **Last Supper Room**.

Enter the Old City through the **Zion Gate** and start a walking tour of the Old City in the Jewish quarter. See the **Burnt House** and the **Herodian Quarter**, a very strong reminder of the Roman conquest and destruction of the Second Temple.

Walk down the stairs to the **Western Wall**, the only remains of the Second Temple and the holiest site for Judaism. Visit the **"Temple Steps"**, a unique archaeological area, with the original steps that led to the entrance of the Temple 2,000 years ago.

Recent excavations show us the **“Western Wall Tunnel,”** huge arched spaces just north of the Western Wall. These link with a water tunnel cut through the rock to the north, apparently dug in the Hasmonean period (163 BC to 37 BC).

Return to the Moshav for dinner and overnight.

## **THURSDAY, DECEMBER 04 - JERUSALEM**

Drive to **Yad Vashem** Holocaust Memorial.

Continue to the **Shrine of the Book** to see the exhibition of the Dead Sea Scrolls. View the model of Jerusalem in the days of Jesus and the Second Temple, displayed in an amazing model scale 1:50.

Drive back to the Old City and visit the **City of David** and see first hand the excavations that reveal the earlier days of Jerusalem dated back to King David.

Whether permits walk the **Hezekiah's Tunnel**.

Return to the Moshav for dinner and overnight.

## **FRIDAY, DECEMBER 05 - JERUSALEM**

Depart Jerusalem and drive east to the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth.

Continue for **Masada**. Take the cable car to the top of the rock and see the Roman palaces, store houses, synagogues and bath house, which witnessed the Jewish resistance to the Romans approximately 2,000 years ago.

Descend by cable car and drive to the Dead Sea for a float in the water.

Continue south to what traditionally have been known as the area of **Sodom and Gemora**.

Return to the Moshav for Shabbat dinner and overnight.

## **SATURDAY, DECEMBER 06 - JERUSALEM**

In the morning, drive to Kibbutz Ramat Rachel for a panoramic view of Bethlehem and Boaz' Fields.

Return to Jerusalem and drive to the **Mt. of Olives** for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Walk down the Mt. of Olives and see the site where Jesus predicted the future destruction of Jerusalem (**Dominus Flevit**), and then on to the Church and **Gardens of Getsemani**. Enter the Christian Quarter of the Old City through **St. Stephen's Gate** and visit the **Pool of Bethesda, St. Anna Church, and the Lithostrothos at the Ecce Hommo Arch**. Walk the **Way of the Cross** to the **Holy Sepulchre Church**.

Continue to the **Garden Tomb**, believed to be the sepulcher and the Garden of Joseph of Arimatheais. A special time of worship and communion is planned in this beautiful garden setting. Return to the Moshav for dinner.

You will be transferred to the airport around 7:00PM for your **nonstop**, Delta Airlines flight # 153 departing Tel Aviv at 11:25PM.

## **SUNDAY, DECEMBER 07 -**

Arrive Atlanta at 6:00AM. After clearing U.S Customs and Immigrations, connect to your **nonstop** Delta Airlines flight # 9735 departing at 8:35AM and arriving Seattle at 11:03AM.
