FRIDAY, MARCH 23 – HAVANA (D)

Depart Miami to Havana with a Charter flight # SK 1801, leaving at 9:00am and arriving Havana Jose Marti airport at 10:00am. Upon arrival, you will be met by a **Ya'lla Tours USA** Cuban representative and transferred to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Then visit the **Christopher Columbus Cemetery** to see some of the lavish tombs of wealthy Cubans from before the revolution.

Continue to the **Seminaries of San Carlos and San Ambrosio**.

TUESDAY, MARCH 27 – HAVANA (B,L,D)

Attend the open-air Mass by **His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI** at **Revolution Square**.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PRICE:

* The price of the tour is: **\$2,440** per person in a double room. The price is guaranteed but if due to unforeseen circumstances beyond **Ya'lla Tours USA Inc.**'s control, our suppliers increase the price, **Ya'lla USA Inc.** will adjust the price accordingly.

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT POLICY:

- * A \$750 per person deposit is required at the time of the booking.
- * Final payment is due on **February 10, 2012.**

CANCELLATIONS & REFUND:

- * **For cancellation up to 45 days prior to departure (February 10, 2012), a \$200 per person administrative fee will apply.**
- * **For cancellation of 44 to 15 days prior to departure, a cancellation fee of 75% of the tour cost will apply.**
- * **For cancellation of 14 days and less prior to departure, a cancellation fee of 100% of the tour cost will apply.**
- * No refund will be paid for unused services such as: transfers, sight-seeing, meals, hotel accommodations, entrance fees, and others that are listed in the tour program.
